**California State University ADT Implementation**  
**Fall 2018**

The historic partnership between the California Community Colleges and the California State University under the Associate Degree for Transfer program guarantees ADT earners admission to the CSU with junior standing after having completed the required 60 units at a community college. Once enrolled at the CSU, students are not required to take more than the 60 necessary units of upper-division coursework to graduate. To fulfill the real promise of the Associate Degree for Transfer program, CSU's must ensure there is a clear pathway for students to transfer under the same program of study as their ADT. Without this, students may be asked to duplicate work they successfully completed at their community college, leading them to spend more time and money on their bachelor's degree.
