

On May 31st, 2023, the Campaign for College Opportunity will present awards for community colleges in California that are successfully supporting students to enroll and succeed in transfer level coursework. These awards will feature categories identifying campuses that are ensuring Latinx and Black students who enroll are supported to enroll in transfer-level English and Math courses, and campuses where they are supported to pass their transfer-level courses within a year of their initial enrollment in the discipline.

**In total there will be 12 categories where colleges will be eligible to receive awards consisting of:**

- **English Enrollment**
  - Campuswide English Enrollment: Highest enrollment rate for all students in English transfer-level courses
  - Black English Enrollment: Highest enrollment rate for Black students in English transfer-level courses.
  - Latinx English Enrollment: Highest enrollment rate for Latinx students in English transfer-level courses.
- **Math Enrollment**
  - Campuswide Math Enrollment: Highest enrollment rate for all students in math transfer-level courses
  - Black Math Enrollment: Highest enrollment rate for Black students in math transfer-level courses.
  - Latinx Math Enrollment: Highest enrollment rate for Latinx students in math transfer-level courses.
- **English Success**
  - Campuswide English Success: Highest throughput rate for all students in English transfer-level courses
  - Black English Success: Highest throughput rate for Black students in English transfer-level courses.
  - Latinx English Success: Highest throughput rate for Latinx students in English transfer-level courses.
- **Math Success**
  - Campuswide Math Success: Highest throughput rate for all students in math transfer-level courses
  - Black Math Success: Highest throughput rate for Black students in math transfer-level courses.
  - Latinx Math Success: Highest throughput rate for Latinx students in math transfer level courses.

### **Percentage Point Gap Minus One**

To identify campuses that are closing equity gaps, the Campaign for College Opportunity is employing a Percentage Point Gap Minus One (PPG-1) methodology, where rates for the demographic subgroup of interest are compared the average of all other students enrolled.

**Example 1: Enrollment PPG-1 for Black Students**

$$PPG - 1_{Black} = \frac{Enroll\ in\ Transfer\ Level_{Black}}{Cohort_{Black}} - \frac{Enroll\ in\ Transfer\ Level_{Not\ Black}}{Cohort_{Not\ Black}}$$

**Example 2: Throughput PPG-1 for Latinx Students**

$$PPG - 1_{Latinx} = \frac{Complete\ TL\ math_{Latinx}}{Cohort_{Latinx}} - \frac{Complete\ TL\ math_{Not\ Latinx}}{Cohort_{Not\ Latinx}}$$

**In order to be eligible for an award, colleges will have to meet each of the following criteria:**

- Have a sufficiently robust cohort size of Black/Latinx students - defined as having at least 20 Black and Latinx students.
- Have a PPG rate for Black or Latinx students above “-1”. This requires that Black/Latinx students are enrolled in transfer-level courses, or are passing those courses, at not more than 1% below the rate of the college’s other enrolled students.
- Those who meet the previous two benchmarks will then be sorted by the relevant rate for their subject and demographic subgroup of interest, with the best performers being selected to receive an Equity Designation.
