



## CSU FULLERTON PROGRESS ON GI 2025 INITIATIVE

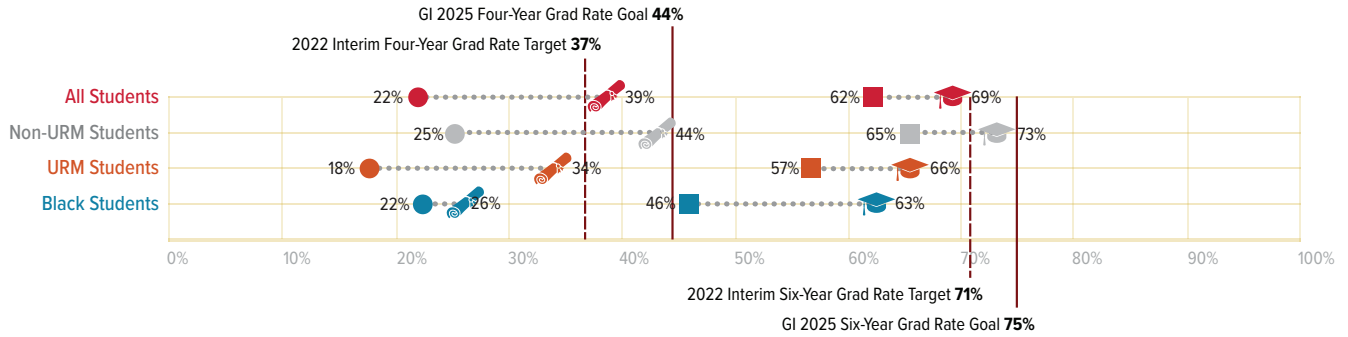
**At CSU Fullerton, the four-year graduation rate for all first-time students has increased from 22% to 39% and the six-year graduation rate has increased from 62% to 69% since 2015.** However, there is a significant gap between non-URM students and URM students after four years of 10 points and seven points at the six-year mark. Black students have even larger gaps, with four-year graduation rates that are 18 points lower, and six-year rates 10 points lower than non-URM students.

**For transfer students, the two-year graduation rate has increased from 32% to 38% and the four-year graduation rate from 75% to 80%.** URM students have a graduation rate one point higher than non-URM students after two years, but three points lower after four, while Black students have larger gaps between themselves and non-URM students of two points after two years and six points after four.

Fullerton has set three of four campuswide goals for GI 2025 at rates above the systemwide goal with the fourth being set only one point lower than the system goal. **The campus is currently on track to reach one of their own GI 2025 goals, along with two of the system goals.** They had been on track to reach all four system goals, before a modest decline in graduation rates for transfer students in 2022.

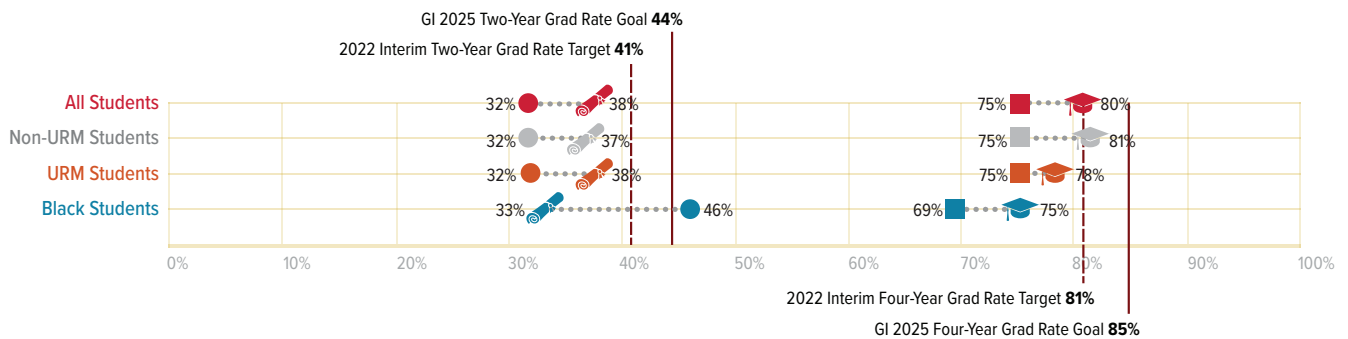
## Four- and Six-Year Graduation Rates for First-Time Students
