



## CAL STATE LA PROGRESS ON GI 2025 INITIATIVE

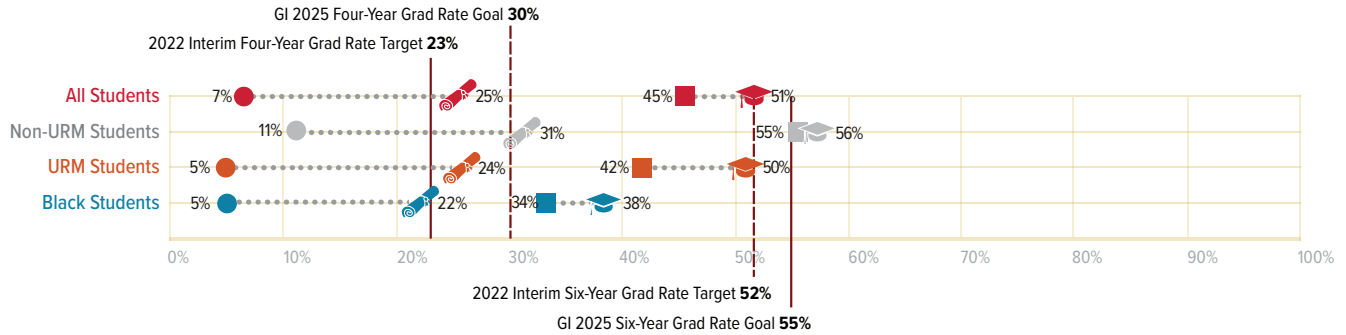
**At Cal State LA, the four-year graduation rate for all first-time students has more than tripled, increasing from seven percent to 25% and the six-year graduation rate has increased from 45% to 51% since 2015.** Gaps persist between non-URM students and URM students- whose graduation rates are seven points lower after four years and six points lower after six. The gaps are larger when comparing Black students to non-URM students at nine points after four years and 18 points after six.

**For transfer students, the two-year graduation rate has increased from 24% to 42% and the four-year graduation rate from 71% to 84%.** There is no gap between URM and non-URM students, but Black transfer students have a two-year graduation rate that is four points lower than non-URM students and a four-year rate that is lower by five points.

Los Angeles has set all its campuswide goals for GI 2025 at rates below the systemwide goals. **The campus is currently on track to reach three of its own GI 2025 goals (with the fourth falling short by less than a percentage point) and two of the systemwide goals.**

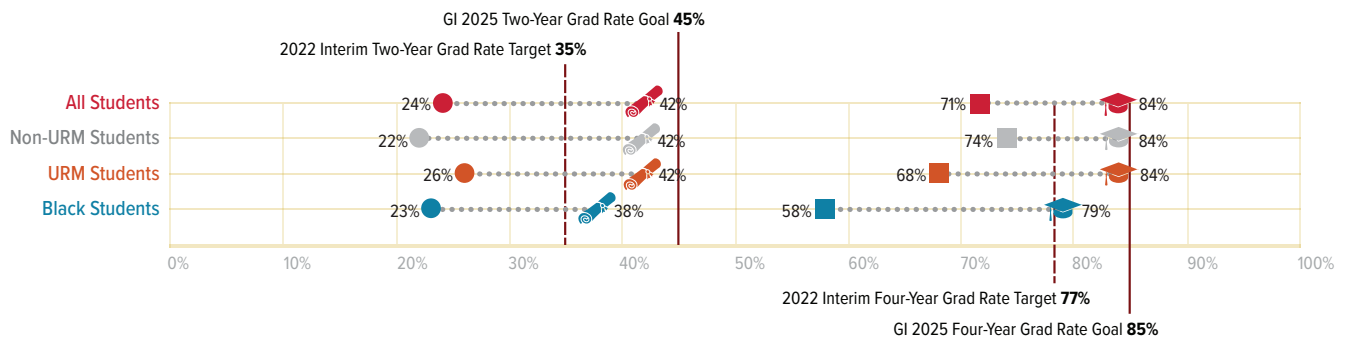
## Four- and Six-Year Graduation Rates for First-Time Students
