



SAN DIEGO STATE PROGRESS ON GI 2025 INITIATIVE

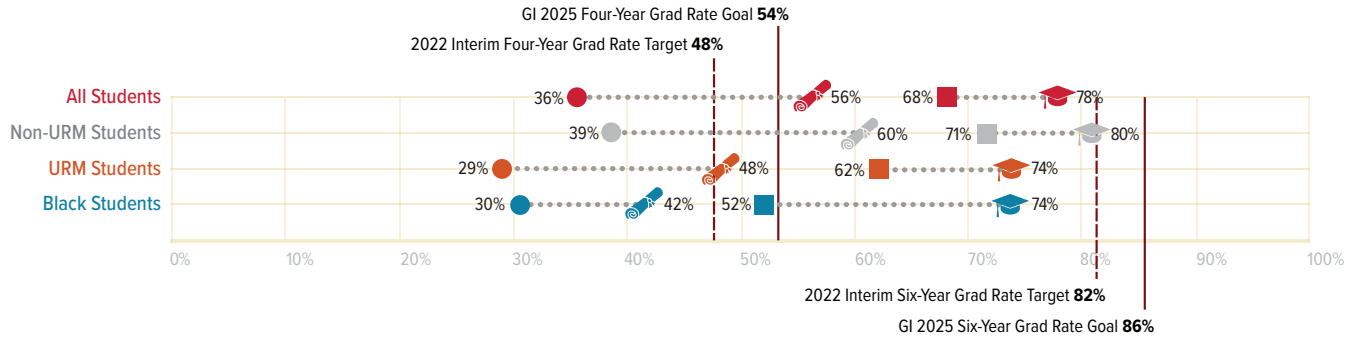
At San Diego State, the four-year graduation rate for all first-time students has increased significantly from 36% to 56% and the six-year graduation rate has increased from 68% to 78% since 2015. Gaps persist between non-URM students and URM students- whose graduation rates are 12 points lower after four years and six points lower after six. The gaps are even starker when comparing Black students to non-URM students at 19 points lower after four years and six points lower after six.

For transfer students, the two-year graduation rate has increased from 39% to 52% and the four-year graduation rate from 81% to 87%. There is a no gap between URM and non-URM students, but Black transfer students have a notable gap compared to non-URM students, with rates that are seven points lower after two years and three points lower after four years.

CSU San Diego has set all of its campuswide goals for GI 2025 at rates above the systemwide goal and their rates before the initiative began were significantly higher than most other campuses. **The campus is currently on track to reach three of its own GI 2025 goals and all the systemwide goals.**

SAN DIEGO STATE GRADUATION RATES

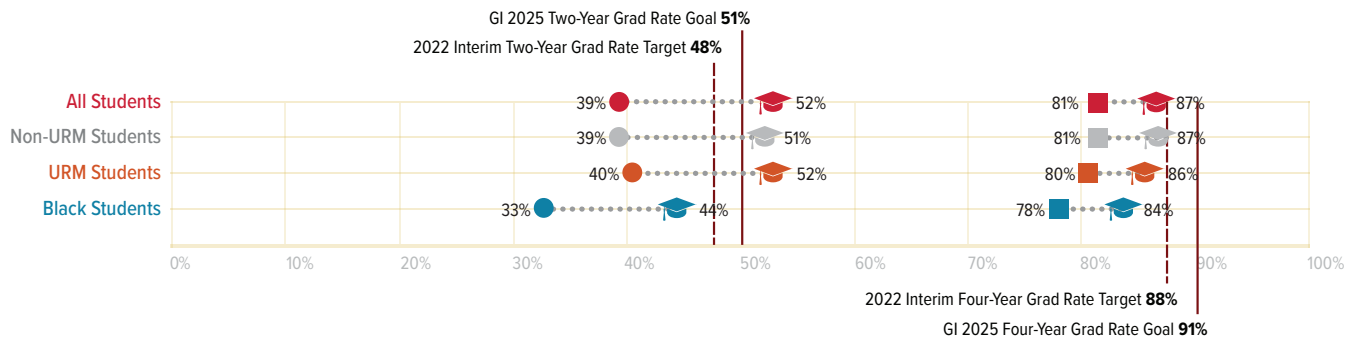
Four- and Six-Year Graduation Rates for First-Time Students
