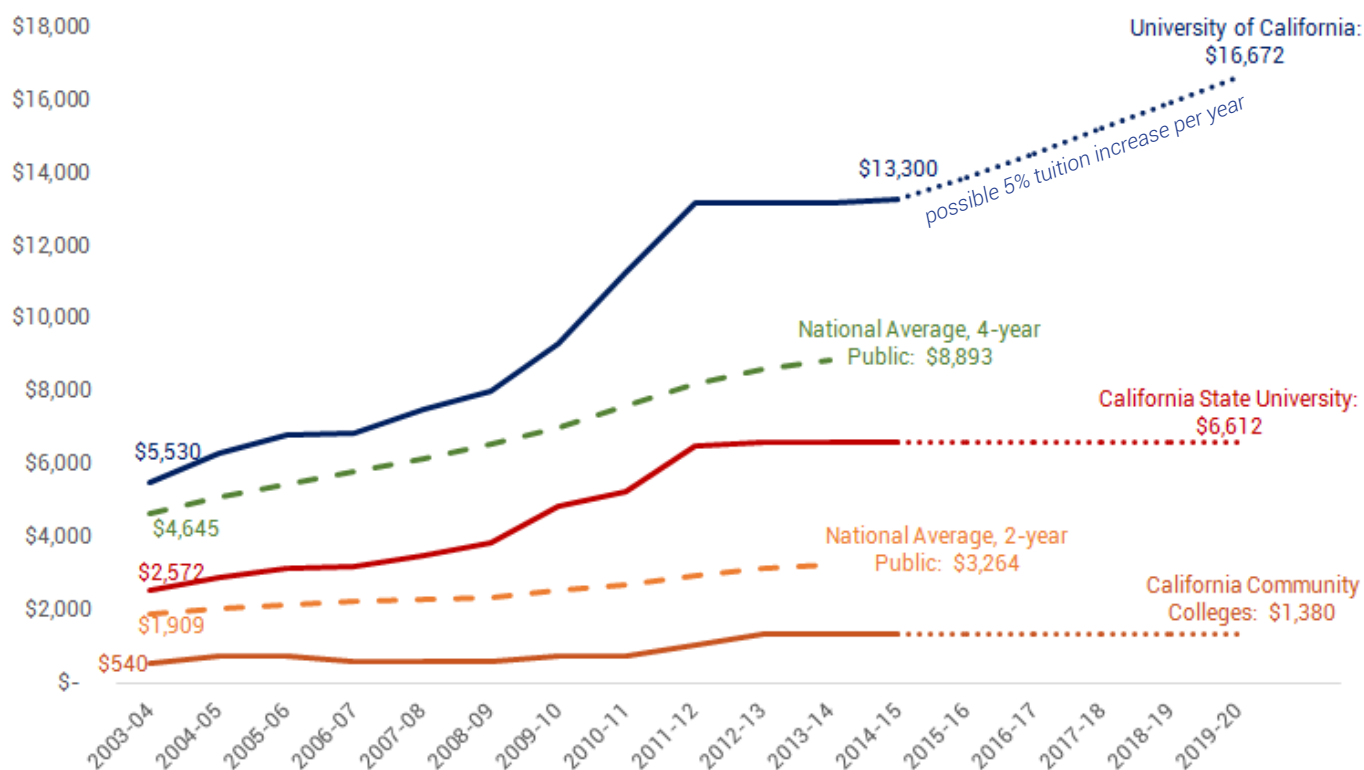


Average Annual Tuition/Fees for California Resident Undergraduate Students



Notes:

The National Average, 4-year Public values include both broad-access institutions like the CSU and research institutions like the UC.

UC rates include systemwide tuition and fees and the average campus-based fees. Projected tuition and fees (demonstrated by dotted line) for years 2015-16 through 2019-20 reflect a 5% tuition increase each year for five years as proposed by the UC Regents on November 19, 2014. An additional \$1,108 in campus-based fees (the average for 2014-15) was added on top of that for consistency.

CSU rates include systemwide tuition for more than 6 units and the average campus-based fees. No projected tuition increases for years 2015-16 through 2019-20 (demonstrated by dotted line).

CCC rates represent the total fee for a full-time load of 30 units. No projected tuition increases for years 2015-16 through 2019-20 (demonstrated by dotted line).
